

## WATERLINE PAPERS – AUTHOR GUIDELINES

Papers should be of a suitable length for the subject

- Between 750 and 5,000 words with illustrations.
- Bear in mind that the paper will probably be included in the on-line version of the Journal, so all necessary permissions for text and photographs/diagrams should be submitted.
- Be non-commercial, product names and company references should be avoided.
- The Author by-line may include a company name.
- CPD points may be awarded, if required, these will be allocated by the CPD committee and may be published in Waterline.
- The author may be asked to compose one or two questions based on the paper, to be published in Waterline, to attract CPD points for respondents, these questions might involve some further reading.
- Every author will receive free membership for the year with The Water Management Society. Benefits include:
  - Waterline journals (quarterly), discounted prices at seminars and conferences, as well as access to the members area and more.

Papers will be scrutinized by the Waterline Editorial Committee before being accepted, so time should be allowed for this process to take place.

Copy dates are posted on-line, but authors should allow at least 2 months before the copy date for scrutiny to take place. The Editorial Committee has final say on the suitability of the paper, and may ask for amendments.
